

List of Valid IDs (at least one):

- Philippine and Foreign government-issued Passport with signature
- Driver's License
- Social Security System (SSS) photo card type ID
- Unified Multipurpose ID (UMID)
- Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) photo card type ID – front and back copy of the ID
- Philippine Postal (PhilPost) ID
- Photo IDs issued by a government owned or controlled corporation, department, agency or instrumentality of the national government including Armed Forces, Philippine National Police, Department of Foreign Affairs, Executive, Legislative, Judiciary, Senate, Philippine Overseas and Employment Agency, Home Development Mutual Fund, Civil Service Commission, Philippine Veterans Affairs Office.
- For any laminated government-issued ID such as Tax Identification Number (TIN) ID, Philhealth ID, Voter's ID and Senior Citizen photo card type ID along with any other photo card type ID such as company ID
- ID issued by the US Embassy and Asian Development Bank to its employees
- **For students of minor age**, School ID (*with student's photo and signature of Principal or Head of School; front and back copy*) along with any of the following: Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Birth Certificate, library ID or membership ID duly issued by any association or organization within the college or university and signed by the pertinent authority issuing the ID
- Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA) ID

For Foreign Nationals (any of the two):

- Foreign government-issued passport with visa (with validity of at least 1 year)
- Alien Certificate of Registration Identity Card (ACR I-Card) with Permanent Resident status (if status on the ACR I-Card is non-immigrant, the expiry date of the ACR I-Card should be more than one year from booking date)
